5.0	Windsor Fire Hazmat MOU	No Action required.
	City of Windsor Fire and Rescue appointed by the Ontario Fire Marshal to become a Hazmat Unit. One of the requirements is to have Paramedics on their unit. Other towns/cities have both services under one municipality. Windsor Essex is separate. An MOU has been drafted and we will find out how many people are required. Selection will be per LOU. LOU has been signed by both parties.	
	Heavy Urban Search and Rescue team will also be coming and members are not permitted to sit on both teams. Windsor Police Services may be developing a team as well.	
6.0	Gordie Howe Bridge Contract	No Action required.
	Contract has gone through legal, still some details to iron out between Bridging North America and EWEMS.	
7.0	Uniform Name Tags	No Action required
	Under Ambulance Act, Paramedics are required to introduce themselves to each patient.	
	Other services use either first name or last name. EWEMS is considering first name. Union suggests using the OASIS number. Other services will be consulted to find best practice.	
8.0	Overspeeds	No Action required
	Overspeeds dropped dramatically after training but they are creeping back up. Reminder to message to members that safe driving is important.	
9.0	Base Cleanliness	No Action required
0	Personal Items are starting to pile up in locker areas. The garages are needing attention to the floors and brushes and other cleaning items are laying around. The kitchen and living areas are ok. Cleaning supplies are provided and the papertowels can be refilled by staff.

12.0	Dry cleaning for municipalities outside Windsor	No Action required
	Paramedics are asked to bring their uniforms to Blondies for cleaning.	
13.0	Wifi for Ruscom and Gesto	No Action required
	Union requests computers at each of these locations. Management will consider it. Keep in mind that trucks have Internet for completing paperwork and checking email as well.	
14.0	Part time points for uniforms	No Action required
	Part time points for uniforms are not allocated as an percentage of hours worked by a full-time member.	
	Management will review current processes.	
15.0	A reduction in part time mandatory availability	No Action required
	Some staff are inquiring to reduce the part time mandatory availability. Management will advise.	
16.0	ACP's switch's with PCP's resulting in two ACP's working together	No Action required
	Budget, staffing pattern and Deployment Plan disallow for two ACP to work in one vehicle. If the switch were approved, the result could be one vehicle is down staffed from ACP to PCP. Block switches between ACP are allowed, ACP to PCP is not. ACP coverage for the entire region is required.	
17.0	ACP in ERV	No Action required
	Staff has brought forth concerns of Overtime practice for ACP when an open ERV shift is available. Management will review and respond.	
18.0	Declining three-way switches	No Action required
	Switches on switches and three-way switches are not permitted and are hard to track and create a lot of work. There is a previous discussion that speaks to this topic that needs to be reviewed.	
19.0	Equal Treatment of EWEMS to the rest of the County EWEMS staff are questioning if they are being included in Corporate events.	No Action required
